Separating multiple songs from a single track

If you have recorded several songs into a single audio track, you can separate the songs by cutting a portion of the audio track and pasting it into a new audio track to create your own customized project.

To separate songs

1. Open a project and select an audio track.
2. Highlight the song you want to copy.
3. Select **Edit > Cut**.
4. Select **File > New**.
5. Select **Edit > Paste**.

NOTE: The new audio track might look very different. This is because the time (width of the waveform) is now only one "song" long.

6. Edit the song.
7. [Save the project](#) or [save the song as an MP3](#).
8. Close the window.

Note: The old audio track, now missing one song, should still be open.

9. Save the old project, or if you are finished editing the remaining single song, [save the song as a MP3](#).

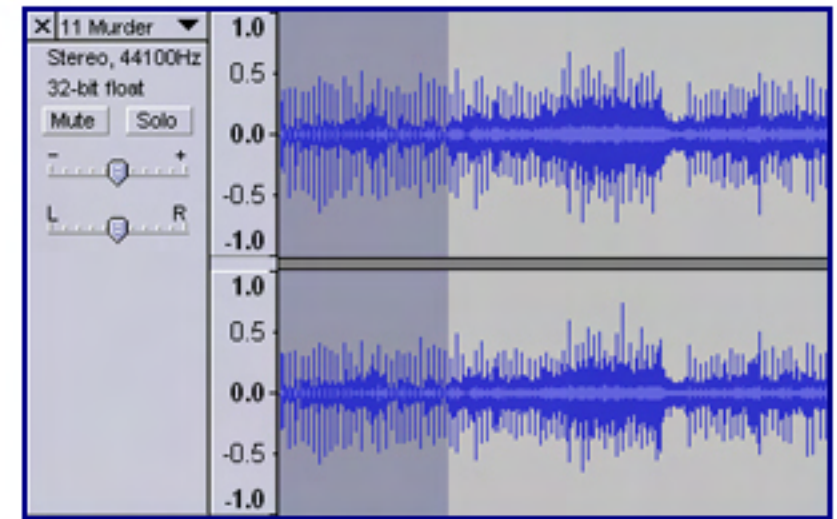


Figure 1. Highlighted audio track
